The Committee will achieve this through a comprehensive, university-wide institutional effectiveness strategy that includes institutional research, outcomes assessment, and evaluation of student learning, student development, and university services and operations. The Committee develops and recommends assessment methods, benchmark targets, strategy, and operational enhancements. The Committee will ensure that the assessment processes align with budgeting and resource allocation. The Institutional Assessment Committee will serve as a nexus for the Administrative Assessment Committee and Academic Assessment Committee to ensure the work of the committees aligns and supports institutional effectiveness.</p> <p>The work of this Committee often occurs in smaller subgroups of the full Committee.</p>
