## Tech & Prototype Lab 207

- 2 student iMacs available. They are on the network. Login with your username and passwords.
- Color printer in the room available for student printing.
- Mobile Clear Touch Panel with built in Huddle Camera and mini-PC. It will automatically login with a default user. Remotes on the lectern.

## Academic Center 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor

Classrooms 303 and 305 have laptops that automatically login with a default user for ease of use and readiness in the rooms. If you need to access files, download them from your OneDrive or Email. Please remember to logout if you use any apps. If you come into the room and it is prompting you to login, simply reboot the laptop and it will automatically login with the default user. Remember you can select Windows Key + “P” to duplicate the screens.

Classrooms 307, 312, and 314 have desktop computers for the Instructors with Dual Screens that automatically connect to the Projector. You will need to login with your credentials. Please logoff when you are done. Remember you can select Windows Key + “P” to duplicate the screens.

## Academic Center 4<sup>th</sup> Floor

All classrooms that have laptops automatically login with a default user for ease of use and readiness in the rooms. If you need to access files, download them from your OneDrive or Email. Please remember to logout if you use any apps.

### NAC 418:

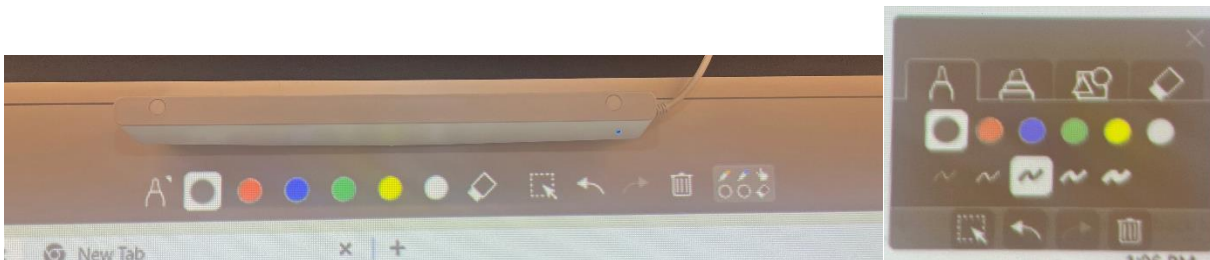
- Technology in the classroom:
  - Interactive touch board & Confidence Monitor
  - Confidence monitor, Ceiling Bar Mic-Array
  - PTZ Camera

How to setup/use the Technology:

- For the interactive smartboard use the Epson remote to power on the projector
  - Then use the smart pens that are stored behind the laptop
    - To use the stylus, you just need to write on the whiteboard where the projector is displaying.



- To change the style/color of the pen use the top bar or by clicking the middle button on the pen to open the quick menu (As shown below)



- For the confidence monitor use the NEC remote to power it on.
  - This will automatically display whatever you display on the laptop
    - **Note: This will not display anything written on the smart board with the stylus**
- The PTZ camera will automatically be turned on when the projector is turned on.
  - The PTZ camera will follow the presenter who is up front while they are using the board
- The Ceiling Mic-array will automatically be turned on when the laptop is turned on.

## NAC 416:

- Technology in classroom:
  - Projector
  - Confidence Monitor

How to use/setup the technology:

- For the Projector use the NEC remote to power it on and pull down the projector screen.
- For the confidence monitor use the Samsung remote to power it on.
  - This will automatically display whatever you display on the laptop

- For the Projector use the NEC remote to power it on and pull down the projector screen.

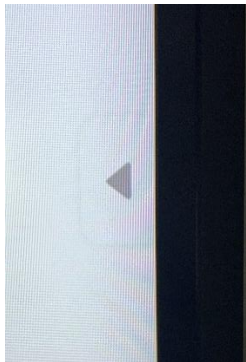

## NAC 403 (Executive Classroom):

- Technology in classroom:
  - Clear Touch display
  - Secondary panel display
  - Poly Studio E70 Camera
  - USB Audio Hub

### How to use/setup the technology:

- A mini pc is attached to the Clear Touch Panel on the main wall. If it doesn't come on automatically, please hold the tiny RESET button in for 10 seconds and Turn if OFF/ON. Back Right side of the Clear Touch Panel.
- For the Clear Touch display & the secondary TV display use the remote to power it on (either one works)
  - The Clear Touch allows you to use the stylus to write on the board as you present.
    - There is a wireless keyboard and mouse that you will use for the computer plugged into the board.
    - To activate this property, you will need to click on the either side of the board where there is an arrow.



- From here tap on the pen icon.



- The secondary display will display what is on the board.



- When a personal device is plugged into the HDMI in the table it will also be displayed on the screen. Ports shown in picture below:



\*\*\* The only one that connects to the screen is at the far end of the table (closest to the window far end). We are still waiting for the BLANK covers for the table from the furniture company. The audio/VGA, USB will NOT work. The desk is not configured to have it.

- For the Poly Studio E70 Camera this will capture the whole room while in a Teams or Zoom meeting.
  - Additionally, it will automatically zoom in on people who are speaking.
    - **NOTE: When multiple people are speaking it will zoom out to capture the whole room.**
- For the USB Audio Hub, this will let you hear audio from videos and people in meetings.
  - Connected to this hub are the microphones mounted to the ceiling.
    - When in a meeting and you are unmuted the lights around the microphones will be green
    - When muted they will be red.
