



How to Turn on the Sharp Display Board

This tutorial will show you how to turn on the Sharp Display Boards in the library.

First, look for the small PC attached to the back of the Sharp Display	2
Click on the black Power button to turn the PC on	3
Find the remote located on the tray and press the power button	4

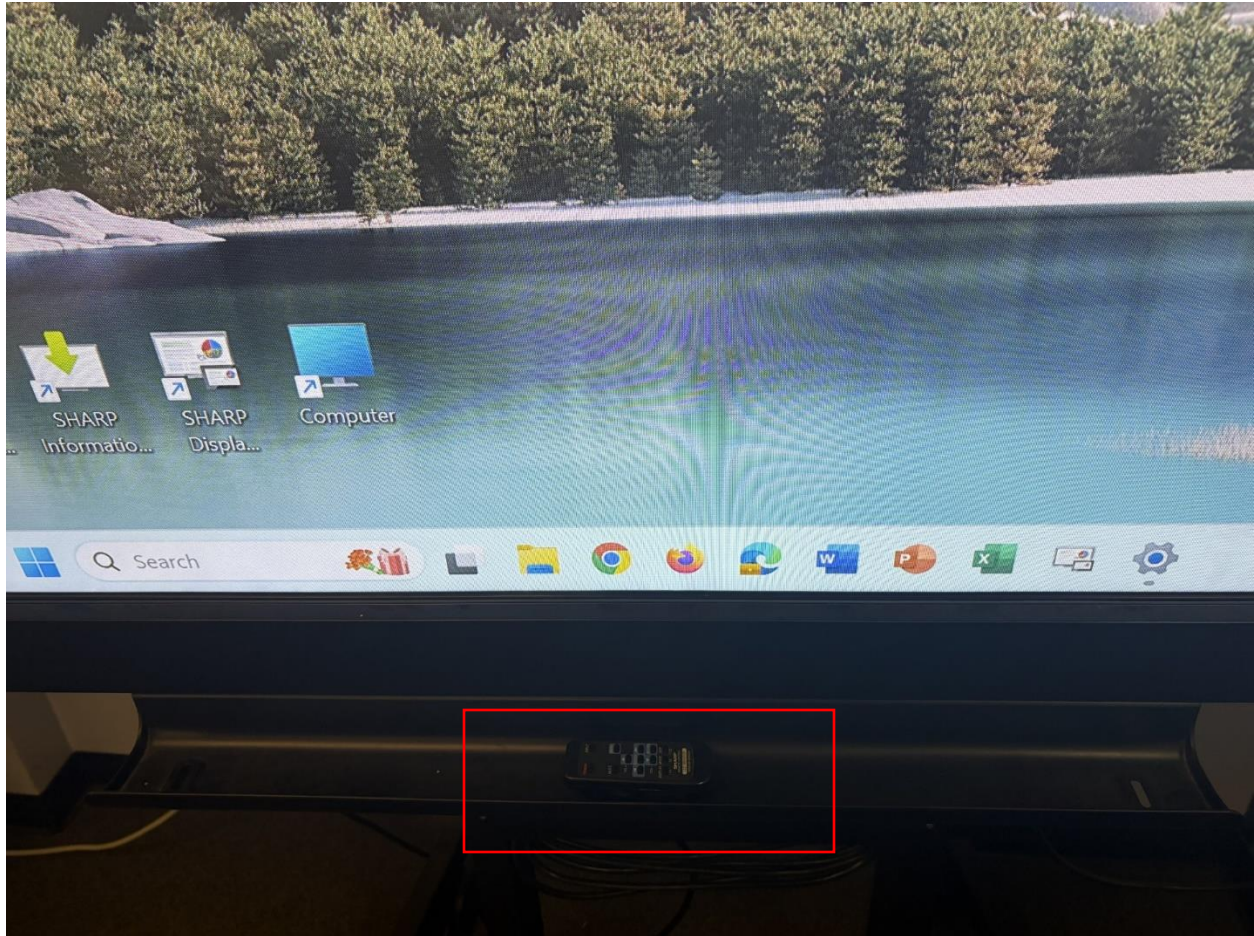

Click on the black Power button to turn the PC on



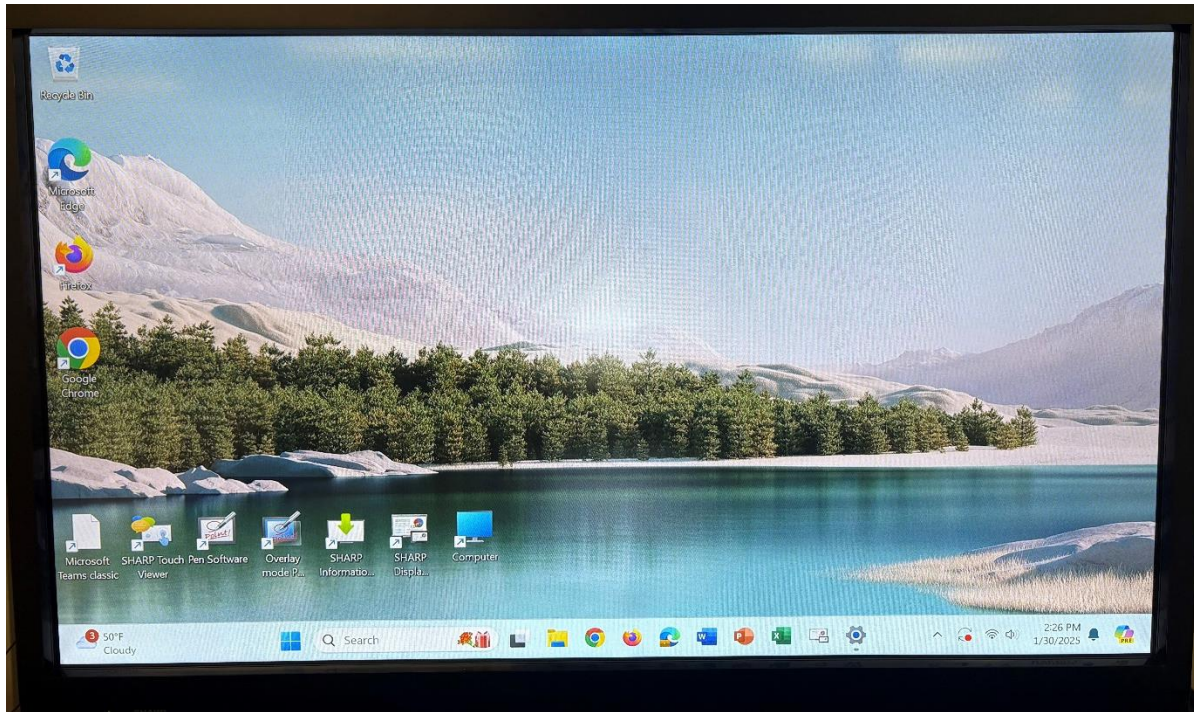
